#### **DETERMINATION BY CONSENT**

1. Pursuant to Rule 39 of the Tribunal Procedure (Upper Tribunal) Rules 2008 and by the consent of the parties the following order is made:

"Upon the determination by First-Tier Tribunal Judge Geraint Jones QC promulgated on  $7^{th}$  June 2017 disclosing a material error of law and being set aside on  $26^{th}$  March 2018.
