JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. The respondents made unlawful deductions from the claimant's wages; and are ordered to pay compensation to the claimant in a sum to be determined.
2. The respondents failed to pay the claimant for accrued holidays; and are ordered to pay compensation to the claimant in a sum to be determined.
3. I declare that the claimant was unfairly dismissed. The amount of compensation payable by the respondents to the claimant will be determined later.
4. The respondents acted in breach of contract in that they failed to give the claimant her notice or make a payment in lieu thereof. The amount of damages to be awarded will be determined later.
