JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1 The complaint of disability-related harassment in respect of the meeting of 7 October 2015 is not well-founded;
- 2 The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider any of the other complaints of disability-related harassment;
- 3 The Tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider the complaint of failure to make reasonable adjustments in respect of the Claimant's move to the UK region in January 2015;
- 4 The other two complaints of failure to make reasonable adjustments are not well-founded:
- 5 The complaint of disability discrimination under section 15 of the Equality Act 2010 is not well-founded.
