JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

- (1) The name of the Respondent on the Tribunal's record is amended to Flower Station Ltd.
- (2) The complaint of unlawful deduction from wages is well-founded. The Respondent shall pay to the Claimant compensation of £2,905.
- (3) The complaint of non-payment of holiday pay is well-founded. The Respondent shall pay to the Claimant compensation of £253.58.
- (4) The Respondent shall pay to the Claimant by way of costs order the sum of £390 as representing the Tribunal's fees.

- (5) The total sum payable by the Respondent to the Claimant is £3,548.58.
