## **JUDGMENT**

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. Both claimants were constructively dismissed by the respondent;
- 2. Both claimants' dismissals were unfair contrary to s94 of the Employment Rights Act 1996;
- 3. Ms Smith's dismissal was wrongful;
- 4. Ms Smith's dismissal was not automatically unfair as per s103A of the Employment Rights Act 1996;
- 5. Ms Smith was not subjected to a detriment contrary to s47B of the Employment Rights Act 1996; and
- 6. Ms Kelledy is awarded £4814.36 in compensation by agreement of the parties and without determination by the Tribunal. This sum is inclusive of £220 Employment Tribunal fees.

The Tribunal granted Ms Smith's request for an adjournment of the hearing to determine remedy in her case, to a date to be notified to the parties by the Tribunal.
