JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

1. The respondent has made unlawful deductions from the claimant wages and is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £345.49.
2. The respondent failed to provide the claimant with an itemised pay statement in respect of the months of November and December 2016 and the particulars that should have been provided in those pay statements would record that the claimant had worked 38.25 hours in November 2016 and 24 hours in December 2016 at the national minimum wage then applicable for an 18- 20-year-old of £5.55 per hour.
