JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim of unlawful deduction from wages is dismissed on withdrawal.
- 2. The Claimant's claim of unfair dismissal is well-founded and succeeds.
- 3. There is a 10% chance that the Claimant would have been fairly dismissed in any event.
- 4. The Claimant contributed to his dismissal by blameworthy conduct and it is just and equitable to reduce his basic and compensatory awards by 10%.
- 5. The Respondent shall pay the Claimant a basic award of £1760.47.
- 6. The Respondent shall pay the Claimant a compensatory award of £613.28.
