## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The Respondent does not contest these claims.
- 2. The following amounts are awarded to be paid to the respective Claimants by the Respondent forthwith:-

to Mr Kamis the sum of £729.87 to Ms Toth the sum of £359.18 to Mr Carter the sum of £712.23

### **REASONS**

- 1. Each Claimant had presented a claim seeking unpaid wages.
- 2. In it's Response the respondent indicated that it did not contest these claims.
- 3. In an e-mail to the Tribunal dated 19 December 2018 the Respondent set out the figures referred to above as the sums it owed to the claimants.
- 4. The Claimants have agreed that these are the sums due to them.
- 5. In those circumstances the hearing fixed for 20 December 2018 has been vacated.
- 6. The tribunal does not have the power in this type of case to
