- 1. The race discrimination claim fails.

- 4. The respondent wrongfully dismissed the claimant without notice and is ordered to pay her £8,190.
- 5. The respondent unfairly dismissed the claimant and is ordered to pay her £7,733 (basic award £ 958, compensatory award £6,775).
- 6. The claimant unreasonably pursued the claims of race discrimination and unlawful deductions from pay, and is ordered to contribute to the respondent's costs in the sum of £15,000.
- 7. No order on the claimant's application for a preparation time order.
