AND Upon there being no evidence that the costs and expenses incurred by the Claimant were caused by any failure of the Respondent to pay wages.

1. The Claimant's claim brought under Section 13 and 23 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 for unlawful deductions from wages are dismissed.
