JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that

1. The claimant's claims under the Equality Act 2010 relating to the protected characteristic of disability are struck out on the basis that the claims have no reasonable prospect of success and the manner in which the proceedings have been conducted has been unreasonable and there has been non compliance with orders of the Tribunal, and the claims have not been actively pursued.
2. The application for costs by the respondent fails and is dismissed.
