## **JUDGMENT**

It is the judgment of the Tribunal that:

- 1. By consent the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £1895.00 in respect of unpaid holiday pay. This is a gross amount and the claimant shall pay to the appropriate authorities on receipt by him any income tax and employee national insurance contributions due in respect of such sum.
- 2. The claim of unfair dismissal is dismissed on withdrawal by the claimant.
- 3. The claim for a declaration of unauthorised deduction from wages in respect of night out allowances is dismissed on withdrawal by the claimant.
- 4. The claim of wrongful dismissal is well-founded and the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £460.00 damages for breach of contract in respect of unpaid notice pay.
- 5. The counterclaim advanced by the respondent is dismissed.
