JUDGMENT

- 1. The claim of direct discrimination because of sex fails.
- 2. The claim of detriment for taking adoption leave is well founded.
- 3. The Tribunal orders the respondent to pay the claimant compensation for unlawful detriment in the sum of £ 26,729.65, made up as follows:
 - 3.1 £13,122.30 special damage, past and future
 - 3.2 £12,500 for injury to feelings
 - 3.3 interest on £ 6,729.95 (loss incurred to date) from 2 July 2017 to 23 January 2018 @ 4% per annum (mid-point), £151.19
 - 3.4 interest on injury to feelings award @ 8% per annum from 9 February 2017 to 23 January 2018, £956.16.
