JUDGMENT

The complaints that the Claimants were unfairly dismissed are struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The Claimants complain of unfair dismissal.
- 2. Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a Claimant to have not less than 2 years service to make a complaint of unfair dismissal.
- 3. The Claimants were employed for less than 2 years.
- 4. Therefore the Claimants are not entitled to bring such a complaint.
- 5. The Claimants have failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaints should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the complaints of unfair dismissal are struck out. The other complaints of unpaid wages and notice pay are not affected by this judgment.
- 7. The case remains listed for hearing on 16 August 2018. The hearing is reduced to 3 hours.
