JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the tribunal is as follows:

1. Upon the claimant's application for reconsideration of the Judgment rejecting the claims in his absence given on 8 March and sent out to the parties on 13 March, the Judgment is set aside.
2. Leave is given (if necessary) to amend the claimant's claim to bring a claim of breach of contract in respect of the non payment of wages.
3. The claimant's claims of:
 - (1) Breach of contract in respect of expenses, contrary to Regulation 3 of the Employment Tribunals Extension of Jurisdiction (England and Wales) Order 1994, and of

(2) Unlawful deduction from wages contrary to Sections 13 and 23 of the Employment Rights Act,

are not well founded and are dismissed.
