# JUDGMENT AT A PRELIMINARY HEARING

1. The complaint of age discrimination is struck out on the grounds that it is not actively pursued and it has no reasonable prospect of success.
2. The complaint of sexual orientation discrimination is struck out on the ground that it has no reasonable prospect of success.
3. This paragraph relates to the claimant's complaint that she was subjected to detriments on the ground that she made protected disclosures on 8 and 19 October 2018 about the conduct of a colleague. That complaint is struck out on the ground that it has no reasonable prospect of success.
4. The tribunal does not strike out the claimant's complaint of indirect discrimination by a principal in relation to religion and belief.
