## JUDGMENT ON PUBLIC PRELIMINARY HEARING

It is the judgment of the Tribunal that:-

1. It is not appropriate to strike out the claims of disability discrimination advanced by the claimant on the basis that the claimant has not complied with Orders of the Tribunal or on the basis that such claims have no reasonable prospect of success pursuant to Rules 37(1)(c) or 37(1)(a) of Schedule 1 to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 ("the 2013 Rules").
2. It is not appropriate to make a Deposit Order pursuant to the provisions of Rule 39 of the 2013 Rules in respect of the claims of disability discrimination.
3. Case Management Orders are issued separately.
