The decision of the tribunal is that:

- 1. The claim of unfair dismissal pursuant to section 103A of the Employment Rights Act 1996 (the 1996 Act) fails and is dismissed.
- 2. The claim of unfair dismissal pursuant to sections 94 and 98 of the 1996 Act succeeds.
- 3. Mr Taylor is entitled therefore to:
 - (a) a basic award of £1,467 but that has been satisfied by the equivalent payment by way of a redundancy payment, and
 - (b) a compensatory award by consent of £450 in respect of loss of statutory rights.
