JUDGMENT

- 1 This was a remote hearing which has been consented to the parties. The form of the hearing was A (fully remote by telephone) .A face to face hearing was not held because it was not practicable and all issues could be determined in a remote hearing.
- 2 The preliminary hearing was converted to a final hearing under rule 48.
- 3 By consent the name of the respondent is changed to Valerie Mullins trading as Valerie Hair Stylists.
- 4 The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £3520.00 (net).
- 5 The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £8654.35.
