# JUDGMENT

1. By consent the claims against Mr M Harris, Mr K Harris and Ms H Harris are dismissed on withdrawal by the claimant.
2. By consent, Go To The Venue Ltd is added as a respondent to the claim
3. By consent, Go To The Venue Ltd has made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages. Go To The Venue Ltd is ordered to pay the claimant unpaid wages in the sum of £96.47 for 11.75 hours work at 8.21 per hour. This is the gross figure, and the claimant will need to account for any tax and national insurance due.
