JUDGMENT

It is the judgment of the Tribunal that the Claimant's complaint of accrued holiday pay is well-founded and succeeds. This sum is to be paid gross and the Claimant is to be responsible for the payment of any income tax and National Insurance Contributions thereon once such sums have been calculated.
