JUDGMENT

The judgment of the tribunal is that:

1. The claimant's claims for unlawful deduction from wages and breach of contract in respect are well founded.
 3. The respondent shall pay to the claimant the gross sum of £315.35 being the amount of the unlawful deduction from wages properly payable to the claimant in respect of furlough pay for the period between 25 July and 31 July 2020.
 4. The tribunal makes no award in the claimant's favour by way of compensation for holiday which the claimant accrued but did not take in the leave year 1 January – 31 December 2019. The claimant was not entitled to carry over any accrued but untaken holiday.
 5. The respondent is ordered to pay the gross sum of £315.35 to the claimant. The respondent shall pay the sum due to the claimant on or before 15 December 2020.
