 - 1.4 unauthorised deduction from wages;
 - 1.5 failure to pay an amount due to the claimant under regulation 14(2) or regulation 16(1) of the Working Time Regulations 1998 (holiday pay).
- 2 The hearing listed for 22nd June 2020 shall be converted to a remedy hearing to consider what, if any, remedy should be awarded to the claimant.
