JUDGMENT

1. The respondent failed to provide the claimant with itemised pay statements, for the period 24 January 2020 up to and including the date of termination of the claimant's employment on 7 June 2020, contrary to section 8 Employment Rights Act 1996. A declaration is made to that effect.
2. The respondent accordingly made a series of unnotified deductions from the claimant's pay and, pursuant to section 12(4) Employment rights Act 1996, the respondent is ordered to pay o the claimant the sum of £350.

The Employment Tribunals (Interest) Order 1990 provides that sums of money payable as a result of a judgment of an Employment Tribunal (excluding discrimination or equal pay awards or sums representing costs or expenses), shall carry interest where the sum remains unpaid on a day ("*the calculation day*") 42 days after the day ("*the relevant judgment day*") that the document containing the tribunal's judgment is recorded as having been sent to the parties.
