JUDGMENT

The claim against the First Respondent for an unpaid statutory redundancy payment succeeds and is upheld. Section 145 of the Employment Rights Act operates such that the relevant date for the claimant's qualifying service is 11 December 2020 meaning that the claimant did have two years qualifying service.

The claimant is awarded the sum of **£494.15** representing the difference between his statutory redundancy entitlement of £711.18 and the sum received by way of part payment of £217.03. The claimant's remaining complaints of unfair dismissal, notice pay and a protective award remain stayed as no consent has been provided to allow those claims to continue.
