JUDGMENT

It is the judgment of the Tribunal that:

1. The name of the respondent is amended to Skinwork Professional Limited trading as Skinwork Global Limited.
2. The claim in respect of unpaid holiday pay is well-founded and the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £484.26 forthwith. This is a gross payment and the claimant is to pay over to the appropriate authorities any income tax and employee national insurance contributions due in respect of such sum.
3. The complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages is not well-founded and is dismissed.
4. The complaint of breach of contract in respect of notice pay is dismissed on withdrawal by the claimant.
