1. The Claimant's form ET1 is amended so that the date on which the Claimant's employment ended is stated in part 5.1 to be 25 June 2021.
2. The Claimant's claim to unauthorised deduction of wages in contravention of section 13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is out of time and is dismissed.
3. The Claimant's claim to a redundancy payment under Part IX of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is well-founded and is upheld.
4. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £7,125.00.
