JUDGMENT

1. It is declared that the respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages in the sum of £432.92 gross. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant £432.92 gross in respect of unpaid wages.
2. The sum ordered to be paid at paragraph 1 above has been calculated as follows:
