JUDGMENT

1. The claim of unfair dismissal is struck out as having no reasonable prospect of success as the claimant was not employed by the respondent.

3. The claim of discrimination because of disability is struck out because the claimant did not disclose his Obsessive Compulsive Disorder to the respondent.
