JUDGMENT

Rule 21 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013

No response has been presented to this claim and an Employment Judge has decided to issue the following judgment on the available material under rule 21:

- 1 The respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the claimant's wages and is ordered to pay the claimant the balance in the gross sum of £6,554.33.
- 2 The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent is ordered to pay damages to the claimant in the net sum of £8,373.03.
- 3 The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay the claimant the balance in the gross sum of £3,687.01 .

- 4 The claimant has suffered loss of employer's pension contributions and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of £1,166.00. Employee's pension contributions have already been included in the gross sum awarded for unlawful deduction of wages.
- 5 The claimant's claim for a redundancy payment is dismissed on the grounds that the Secretary of State has paid the claimant the statutory entitlement in full.
