JUDGMENT

1. The Claimant’s complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages is well-founded and succeeds. The Respondent shall pay the Claimant **£5809.44**. That is the net wages owed. If any tax and National Insurance is payable on that, the Respondent is responsible additionally for paying it.
2. The Respondent shall also pay the Claimant a sum equivalent to two weeks’ pay in respect of its failure to provide him with a written statement of employment particulars. The sum payable is **£901.92**.
