  - (b) Unauthorised deductions from wages (arrears of pay).
  - (c) Unauthorised deductions from wages (holiday pay).
- 3. The claim for breach of contract (expenses) is withdrawn and is dismissed.
- 4. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the following sums (gross):

<u>Unauthorised deductions (arrears)</u>

£22,300 less £3703 already paid = £18,597.00

Unauthorised deductions (holidays)

14.6 days at £417.32 per day = £ 6,092.87
