# JUDGMENT

1. By consent the Respondent's name is amended to "Myomaster Ltd".
2. The Claimant's claim for redundancy pay is not well founded and is dismissed.
3. The Respondent has made unlawful deductions from the Claimant's wages in the sum of £2,469.37 gross and is to pay that sum forthwith.
4. Upon receipt of the monies referenced in paragraph 3 above, the Claimant is to account to HMRC for any tax or National Insurance contributions owed.
