JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is as follows:

1. The claimant's claim for notice pay is well-founded. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant notice pay in the sum of £753.85 gross, subject to any deductions of tax and national insurance the respondent may be obliged to make.
2. The claimant's claim for the unauthorised deduction of wages pursuant to section 13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is well-founded. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £3316.94 gross, subject to any deduction of tax and national insurance the respondent may be obliged to make.
3. The claimant's claim for accrued and outstanding holiday pay pursuant to Regulation 14 of the Working Time Regulations 1998 is well-founded. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £134.62 gross, subject to any deductions of tax and national insurance the respondent may be obliged to make.
4. Total award = £4205.41
