## **JUDGMENT**

- The claimant's claim of unauthorised deduction from wages was presented outside the primary time limit of 3 months and the tribunal is not satisfied that it was not reasonably practicable for the claim to be presented before the end of that period of 3 months. Consequently, the tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear the claim and it is dismissed.
- The claimant's complaints of age discrimination and race discrimination were presented outside the primary time period of 3 months and the tribunal finds that it is not just and equitable to extend time. Consequently, the tribunal does not have jurisdiction to hear those complaints and they are dismissed.
