JUDGMENT

The claim for discrimination on the grounds of sexual orientation is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated 7th February 2024 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim for discrimination on the grounds of sexual orientation should not be struck out because

- the claimant had not complied with the order of the Tribunal dated **11th April 2023, 19th September 2023, and 28th October 2023**
- it has not been actively pursued.

2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The claim for discrimination on the grounds of sexual orientation is therefore struck out. The other claims remain extant.
