JUDGMENT

The complaint of Unfair Dismissal is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated **1 October 2024** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the complaint of **unfair dismissal** should not be struck out because Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years' service to make an unfair dismissal complaint. And the claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 2. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaint should not be struck out or to request a hearing.
- 3. Accordingly, the complaint of unfair dismissal is struck out. The claimant's other complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is not affected by this judgment.
- 4. The claimant's remaining claim remains listed for hearing on 21 January 2025 with a time estimate of 3 hours.
