## **JUDGMENT**

**Employment Tribunals Procedure Rules 2024 - Rule 22** 

The claims of unauthorized deduction from wages and outstanding holiday pay succeed and the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the following sums:

Unauthorized deduction from wages – the gross sum of £2,242.00. Outstanding holiday pay – the gross sum of £142.22.

Total - £2,384.22

The claim of Disability discrimination is dismissed upon withdrawal.

## Reason

- 1. Upon considering the submissions of the claimant more and all the available material I am satisfied that a determination can be made of the claims.
- 2. The claimant presented a claim to the Employment Tribunal of I, unauthorized deduction from wages and outstanding holiday pay and disability discrimination. The claim for disability discrimination is withdrawn.
