DECISION NOTICE

1. The Registrar's case management note of 23 March 2016 sets out the position reached in this case, the circumstances of which are plainly troubling.
2. There has been no compliance with the directions given in paragraph 10 of that note. The appellant (whoever he really is) has been put on notice that non-compliance could result in the proceedings being struck out.
3. The Tribunal can see no reason for prolonging these proceedings. They are accordingly struck out pursuant to rule 8(3)(a) of the Tribunal Procedure (First-tier Tribunal) (General Regulatory Chamber) Rules 2009.
4. The proceedings are also struck out pursuant to rule 8(3)(c) on the basis that, for the reasons given in paragraph 10 of the second respondent's response of 8 February 2016, there is no reasonable prospect of the appeal succeeding.
