Decision (including any steps ordered)

1. The complainant requested information on 29 January 2013. The Home Office responded on 27 February 2013.

- 2. The Commissioner's decision is that the Home Office has breached section 10(1) of the FOIA.
- 3. The Commissioner does not require the Home Office to take any further steps.

Request and response

- 4. On 29 January 2013 the complainant wrote to the Home Office (HO) requesting information.
- 5. The HO responded on 27 February 2013.

Scope of the case

- 6. The complainant contacted the Commissioner 18 March 2013 to complain about the way his request for information had been handled.
- 7. The Commissioner will consider the length of time taken by the HO to respond to the complainant's request.

Reasons for decision

8. Section 10(1) of FOIA states that:

'a public authority must comply with section 1(1) promptly and in any event not later that the twentieth working day following the date of receipt.'

- 9. The Commissioner notes that in order for the HO to have complied with the 20 day working limit set out in section 10 of the FOIA, it should have responded to the complainant promptly and no later than the twentieth working day after receipt. In this case that would have been 26 February 2013. However, the HO responded on 27 February 2013.
- 10. The Commissioner therefore considers that the HO has breached section 10(1) of FOIA.
