**FURTHER DECISION** 

1. In my decision dated 24 July 2000 I indicated that I was minded to order Mr Magill to

assign forthwith the patent application in issue to Intelligent Clothing Ltd, but I gave him six

weeks to say whether he wished to resist such an order. No reply was received, and so in a

letter dated 11 September 2000 Mr Magill was informed that, since no response had been

received, the Patent Office assumed that he did not oppose the assignment.

2. Accordingly I order Mr Magill to assign Patent Application No PCT/GB 92/02064 to

Intelligent Clothing Limited within six weeks from the date of this decision. As explained in

my previous decision, I have no jurisdiction in respect of the US patent that has already been

granted pursuant this application, so my order does not extend to that patent.

Costs

3. As no party has been put to any significant expense since my previous decision, I

make no order as to costs in respect of this further decision.

**Appeal** 

4. This decision is not on a matter of procedure, so any appeal should be filed within six

weeks.
