SUPPLEMENTARY DECISION

My written decision in these proceedings, 1 November 2000, contained a clerical error. It has been brought to my attention that when awarding costs against the applicant, I erroneously identified him as Mr Findlay. The necessary power to correct this is provided by Part 40.12 of the Civil Procedure Rules which states:

“40.12 - (1) The court may at any time correct an accidental slip or omission in a judgement or order.”

I therefore correct the final paragraph of my written decision in these proceedings to read as follows:

“The opposition having been successful the opponents are entitled to a contribution towards their costs. I order the applicant, Mr Assali, to pay the opponents, the sum of £635. This sum to be paid within seven days of the expiry of the appeal period or within seven days of the final determination of this case if any appeal against this decision is unsuccessful.”
