DECISION

- 1 Patents Form 7/77 names one inventor: John Mark Counsell
- 2 Building Research Establishment Ltd and The University of Strathclyde, the patent proprietors, have now made an application under rule 10(2) of the Patents Rules 2007 to the effect that Matthew John Stewart and Andrew Williams should also have been named as joint inventors.
- 3 John Mark Counsell has provided written consent to the application. For their part, Matthew John Stewart and Andrew Williams have also filed written consent confirming they should be named as joint inventors. I therefore conclude that all relevant parties agree that Matthew John Stewart and Andrew Williams should be named as joint inventors.
- 4 Accordingly I find that Matthew John Stewart and Andrew Williams should be mentioned as joint inventors in the published patent application and I direct, in accordance with rule 10(1) that an addendum slip mentioning them as joint inventors be prepared for the published patent application for the invention.
