Mr. Goldthorp and Mr. Heddon, their Lordships have given anxious consideration to this case, both before the hearing and during the hearing. They are completely satisfied that there has been no illegality in the procedure adopted in the preparation of the Scheme and they think it is a valid Scheme. They have listened carefully to what you have had to say supplementing your petition and your affidavits, and after giving careful consideration to the whole matter, they are clearly and firmly of the opinion that the Scheme must be allowed to go forward. Their Lordships will accordingly humbly advise Her Majesty that the appeal be dismissed and the Scheme confirmed.
