I am directed by Sir Denis Hill, as the member of the Council authorised to act in that behalf, to notify you in accordance with Rule 5(2) of the Disciplinary Committee (Procedure) Rules 1970 that the Council has received from the Home Office information which appears to raise a question whether, as a registered medical practitioner, you have committed serious professional misconduct within the meaning of Section 33(1) of the Medical Act 1956 as amended by Section 13(1) of the Medical Act 1969. A copy of the relevant provisions is enclosed together with copies of the Procedure Rules and of a pamphlet on Professional Discipline.

In the information it is alleged that, between about April 11, 1973 and about February 19, 1974, in return for fees, you issued prescriptions for drugs otherwise than in the course of bona fide treatment, and in particular you so issued the prescriptions set out in the enclosed schedule.

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 5 of the Procedure Rules, Sir Denis Hill may direct the Registrar to refer the information to the Penal Cases Committee of the Council; and in this event it will be the duty of that Committee to consider the information and any explanation furnished by you and to determine whether the case shall be referred to the Disciplinary Committee of the Council for inquiry into a charge against you.

The next meeting of the Penal Cases Committee will be held on May 21, 1974. I am accordingly to invite you to submit to the Council any explanation of your conduct which you may have to offer.

Re: Your letter M56/MP of 13/5/74
(General Medical Council)

Please refer to your letter as above which you inadvertently sent to my 14 Regent Road address whereas I am at 229 Portland Road, B'ham 17, the result being that it was delivered today 17/5/74 second post. I have told this to your deputy on telephone.

As explained to you, I don't agree that I have done malafide treatment and hence I have seen them the patients as individuals and not as a group, and hence any suggestion by the Home Office (Mr Spears of Home Office) would be disregarded by me.

(1) I have not issued prescriptions just to obtain money but the patients have come as individuals and I have treated him/her to the best of my abilities, realising fully well that I would be labelled as incapable and ignorant if I send them to the doctor next door.

(2) I have reviewed all the cases here and practically many of them have come for lack of energy, spirits, enthusiasm and loss of sleep, obesity, inability to concentrate and sleep, and whatever medicine I have prescribed has been for the well being of the patient.

I have prescribed medicines (drugs) for a week to a fortnight basis at the best. It has happened as I have been stated that in a few cases the medicine in the possession of the patient has been lost from him and that he has taken a little more of the drug for his well being and hence after proper verification and under oath of the patient, I have given him the repeat prescription but this has been very few and that also on human reasons. Also, I have to tell that I won't treat any patient assuming him to be a scoundrel. I may have erred in my clinical judgment but not in the substance. Many of the patients have never returned to me realising I am very stiff with them. You have also to realise that the surgery are closed on the weekend (except for urgent cases) and hence to avoid a rush on Monday prescription for the next week have been issued on Saturday or Friday evening for the quantity due for next week.

And anyway after receipt of the threatening letter of the G.M.C. of 9.4.75 I have stopped completely prescribing any amphetamine, diconals or turnals for the patients stated therein.

I hope this clarifies the situation. I have helped and responded immediately in the course of better medicine.

(1) As I have explained to you on telephone, your letter (ie the copies of the G.M.C.'s letter and statement regarding patients) did not come until Friday, 17/5/74 second post and hence the delay. I have analysed them all. As I feel that you may not have sufficient time to scrutinise my letter for a reply from your side as well as the G.M.C., I have telephoned and talked for about 14 minutes to the G.M.C. I have spoken to Mr Gray, the Assistant Registrar, his secretary, Miss Humphreys and Mr Draper's (Registrar) secretary and conveyed to each of them that due to so many difficulties in communication my backlog of work (due to myself being away in West Indies) and over-accumulation of clinical work which could not have been done by me deputy in my absence, it has not been possible for me to send a reply. I have asked for an extension of a fortnight's time so that you could have full opportunity to see that it is legally alright before submitting them to the G.M.C.

(2) I have also sent G.M.C. a telegram today 20/5/74 as follows - Genmedicwa, London, WC1 (telegraphic address of G.M.C.) reference - MRD/OEH/PDI/6615 - Unavoidable postal communication disruption pray extend time fortnight. Letter follows - Dr Prasad. I have confirmed that in my letter of today which I have sent to the G.M.C. marked for Mr Gray (Assistant Registrar) as Mr Draper (Registrar) is not in.has tomorrow. I have also sent a copy of the same letter to you so that have asked for extension of time for a fortnight also spoken to your secretary telling her this so that she informs you. I am sure Mr Gray will act accordingly. I am sorry the post office asked me that if I put my letter by express post or recorded delivery, the delivery to you or any person would be delayed. hence sent to

Regarding the case for the G.M.C. itself the points are as below:-

(i) From the G.M.C. letter it appears that I am just interested in the good of patients described by them. I am sorry that I have not seen them as a group but as individuals, who have got full rights to come to me as to any other doctor and I would think myself as a sub-standard or third rate incompetent doctor if I am not able to listen to the patients and treat them accordingly. I am a practitioner with surgeries on the main trunk road and it has happened in the past that when I have denied treatment to a patient or patients I have been rebuked and called bad names.

(2) No substantial amounts of amphetamines or barbiturates have been written, but hardly a supply of a week or two weeks (fifteen days at best) have been given. Number of days have not been short but just the week days when the surgery is in session, namely I had to give the patients treatment so that he did not suffer at the weekend or on holidays or on my ha days etc. The interval has never been that except in a very few cases when the patient genuinely conveyed that he has lost his medicine and that was also under oath of the patient. After all I am also a human being and I don't work on the presumption that a particular patient/or a person is scoundel to begin with. The patients in general, had complaints of lack of concentration, enthusiasm, energy and inability to concentrate. I devote to the work. They also had pains in the body with lack of sleep and many had obesity problems. I have worked for the physical and mental well being of the patients and have not given malafide treatment. Many did not see my face after second or third time since I was very strict with them and asked them to go elsewhere.

(3) I may have been erring in my clinical judgment but nothing have I done to hang my head in shame. The amount of clinical dosage has varied according to patients but that was my clinical judgment which depends upon so many factors.

I had asked the patients to come to my N.H.S. list but they have stubbornly refused the offer and in many cases, I did not like to take them if they were living far away.

I can further assure you that since the appeal of the Home Office representative I have stopped prescribing amphetamine, barbiturates and other drug and it has completely been stopped with effect from 3 April 74. It must be appreciated that whatever referrals I have made to the Psychiatric Clinic have either been turned down or gone into default. I am not a law breaker and don't believe in it and if our medical colleagues don't like it, I have to submit straight way so that I could serve for the better cause of medicine which is my profession and vocation.

You can assure the G.M.C. that I have taken it seriously and am taking and have taken guidance in this field. In particular I have taken name of Mr Terry Beston who had committed suicide on his own account, but anyway please discuss with me before sending any reply to the G.M.C. You can also tell them about ???
