I Loke Chow Kit of Kuala Lumpur in the Federated Malay States hereby revoke all former Wills and codicils made by me and declare this to be my last Will.

I appoint Loke Chow Thye, Loke Yaik Foo and my wife Chan Yoon Lin all of Kuala Lumpur aforesaid to be the trustees and executors of this my Will and the guardians of my infant children and I give and bequeath to each of my trustees who accept the office of trustee and executor the annual sum of Dollars six hundred (\$600/-) to commence from the date of my death payable by equal monthly payments and to continue during a period of five years from the date of my death.

And I hereby specially authorise and empower my trustees to receive such monthly payments as they accrue due and without waiting for the complete distribution or administration of my estate.

I devise and bequeath to Loke Chow Thye all my property situate in Penang Hill and known as Mon Sejour.

I devise and bequeath to my nephew Loke Hung Hee and to my son Loke Yaik Ho by Choo Ah Part absolutely in equal shares all my property of whatsoever nature situate and being in Soon Tark, Canton, China.

I bequeath the following pecuniary legacies to my aunts Lee Geok Mee and Wong Choon Moey the sum of Dollars five hundred (\$500/-) each and to my sister Loke Quai Kee the sum of Dollars One thousand (\$1000/-).

I bequeath an annuity of Dollars Three thousand six hundred (\$3600/-) to my wife Chan Yoon Lin to commence from the date of my death and to continue during her life or until she marries again (whichever shall first happen) such annuity to be paid free of all deductions whatsoever by equal monthly payments of Dollars three hundred (\$300/-) and I direct my trustees to appropriate in their names

investments of any nature that they may think fit of an amount sufficient at the date such appropriation to answer the said annuity out of the income thereof and I declare that such income shall be the primary fund for answering

said capital of the said investments from the secondary fund for answering the same event of the income proving insufficient and further that after such appropriation shall have been made my residuary estate or the income thereof shall no longer be liable to provide for such annuity but may be appropriated and distributed among the persons entitled thereto.

I devise and bequeath all the real and personal estate not hereby or otherwise specifically disposed of and which I can dispose by will in any manner I think proper unto my trustees upon the trusts and subject to the powers and provisions hereinafter declared.

And as to all the tin mining land in the Federated Malay States, Johore Kedah and Siam of which I am the registered lessee or registered proprietor or in which I have any share or interest upon trust to pay to my brother Loke Chow Thye one half of the income derived therefrom and if when sold (and the time of any such sale shall be in the absolute discretion of my trustees) upon trust to pay the said Loke Chow Thye one half of the proceeds thereof.

And as to my share and interest in the partnership business carried on in Kuala Lumpur or elsewhere under the name or style of Chow Kit and Company I direct my trustees as soon as possible after my death to use their best endeavours to form the said partnership business into a limited liability company under the Companies Enactment of 1897 or subsequent enactment and I further direct that if no such limited liability company is formed the amount of my share and interest in the said business or in the event of such limited liability company being formed the shares allocated to my estate as representing the amount of my shares and interest in the present partnership business shall be divided by my trustees into fifteen equal parts and my trustees shall stand possessed of the same as to three of such parts in trust for my wife Chan Yoon Lin and as to the remaining twelve parts in trust to divide the same equally amongst my children Loke Soh Sin, Loke Soh Tuan, Loke So Keen, Loke Yaik Foo, Loke Soh Gaik, Loke Soh Choo,

twenty thousand (\$20000/-) upon trust to invest
such sum in or upon such investments as my
trustees may think fit and to hold such invest-
ments upon trust to pay the income thereof to my
wife Chan Yoon Lin during her life time and after
the death of the said Chan Yoon Lin the said
trust fund of Dollars Twenty thousand (\$20000/-) to
be held in trust for such person or persons as the
said Chan Yoon Lin may be deed or by will or
codicil appoint and in default of any such
appointment and subject to any partial appoint-
ment the said trust fund of dollars twenty
thousand (\$20000/-) shall be held in trust for my
two daughters Loke Soh Tuan and Loke Soh Sin and
all the children or any of the child of the said
Shan Yoon Lin equally and who shall be living at
the time of the death of the said Chan Yoon Lin
and shall attain the age of twenty on years.

I direct that my trustees shall invest in such
manner as they think fit the residue of the
proceeds of the said sale calling in and conversion

And to empower my trustees in their absolute discretion to apply to such sums or sum as they think fit for the maintenance education or benefit of any of my said children. I give and bequeath the sum of Dollars two thousand (§2000/-) unto my trustees upon trust that my trustees shall invest the same upon such investments as they think for the purpose of establishing a scholarship fund and the annual income arising from such investments shall be called the Loke Chow Kit prize and shall be paid by my trustees to the scholar who attains the highest number of marks amongst scholars resident in Kuala Lumpur under the auspices of the Cambridge University or such other standard examination as may from time to time be held in Kuala Lumpur and I give devise and bequeath the whole of the residue of my real and personal property whatsoever and wheresoever not hereinbefore otherwise disposed of unto my sons and daughters and who shall be living at the date of my death and who shall attain the age of twenty one years to be divided into sixteen parts as follows:-

- B. To agree and settle accounts with all persons liable to account to my estate for that purpose to execute effectual receipts releases and discharges. No trustee of this my Will shall be liable for any loss not attributable to his or her own dishonesty or to the wilful commission by him of an act known by him to be a breach of trust and in particular he shall not be bound to take any proceedings against a co-trustee for any breach of trust committed by such co-trustee.
