1982 CHAPTER 7

An Act to increase the limit imposed by section 60 of the New Towns Act 1981 on the amounts which may be borrowed by development corporations and the Commission for the New Towns. [25th February 1982]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. In section 60 of the New Towns Act 1981 (limit on borrowing Increase of by development corporations and Commission for New Towns) for limit on "£3,625 million or such greater sum not exceeding £4,000 million" borrowing. there shall be substituted "£4,500 million or such greater sum not 1981 c. 64. exceeding £5,000 million".
 - 2.—(1) This Act may be cited as the New Towns Act 1982.

Citation and extent.

(2) This Act does not extend to Northern Ireland.
