The Bermuda Constitution (Amendment) Order 1968

Made - - - - 22nd March 1968
Laid before Parliament 28th March 1968
Coming into Operation 29th March 1968

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 22nd day of March 1968

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in Her in that behalf by section 1 of the Bermuda Constitution Act 1967(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Bermuda Constitution (Amendment) Order 1968, and the Bermuda Constitution Order 1968(b) and this Order may be cited together as the Bermuda Constitution Orders 1968. Citation and commencement.

(2) This Order shall come into force on 29th March 1968.

2. Paragraph (a) of section 43(2) of the Constitution set out in Schedule 2 to the Bermuda Constitution Order 1968 is amended by the substitution of the word "four" for the word "fourteen". Amendment of section 43 of the Constitution of Bermuda.
