The Bermuda Constitution (Amendment) (No. 2)

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in Her in that behalf by section 1 of the Bermuda Constitution Act 1967(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Bermuda Constitution (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1968, and shall be included among the Orders that may be cited together as the Bermuda Constitution Orders 1968.

(2) This Order shall be construed as one with the Bermuda Constitution Order 1968(b) (hereinafter called "the principal Order"), as amended by the Bermuda Constitution (Amendment) Order 1968(c).

(3) This Order shall come into operation on 15th May 1968.

2. The principal Order is amended by the insertion therein immediately after section 7 of the following section:—

"First appointment of Secretary to Executive Council.
 7A. Subsection (2) of section 90 of the Constitution set out in schedule 2 to this Order shall not have any application to the first appointment made under subsection (1) of that section to the office of Secretary to the Executive Council."
