The Kirklees (Related Alterations) Order 2010

Made - - - - *19th August 2010*

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Under section 92(2) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007(a) (“the 2007 Act”) the Council of the Borough of Kirklees(b) made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England(c) for the related alteration of the boundaries of district wards within the Council’s area.

The Local Government Boundary Commission for England has decided to give effect to the recommendations and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 92(3) of the 2007 Act makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Kirklees (Related Alterations) Order 2010.
- (2) This Order comes into force—
 - (a) for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the elections of councillors for district wards, on 15th October 2010;
 - (b) for all other purposes, on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2011.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“map” means the map defined in article 2 of the 2009 Order, of which prints are available for inspection at the offices of the Council of the Borough of Kirklees and at the principal office of the Local Government Boundary Commission for England;

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983(d);

“the 2009 Order” means the Council of the Borough of Kirklees (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2009(e).

- (a) 2007 c.28. Section 92 has been amended by section 67(1) of, and paragraphs 11 and 32 of Schedule 4 to, the Local Democracy, Economic Development and Construction Act 2009 (c.20) (“the 2009 Act (c.20)”).
 - (b) The metropolitan district of Kirklees has the status of a borough.
 - (c) The Local Government Boundary Commission for England was established by the 2009 Act (c.20). The functions of the Electoral Commission under Chapter 3 of Part 4 of the 2007 Act (c.28) were transferred under section 60 of the 2009 Act (c.20) to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England on 1st April 2010.
 - (d) 1983 c.2. Section 37 has been amended by section 18(2) of the Representation of the People Act 1985 (c.50), section 17 of the Greater London Authority Act 1999 (c.29) and section 60 of the 2007 Act (c.28).
 - (e) The Council of the Borough of Kirklees (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2009 was made by the Council of the Borough of Kirklees under section 86 of the 2007 Act (c.28).

Related alterations of district ward boundaries

3.—(1) Each area described in column 1 of the Schedule ceases to be part of the district ward named in column 2 of the Schedule and becomes part of the district ward named in column 3 of the Schedule.

(2) In this article “district ward” means a ward established by the Borough of Kirklees (Electoral Changes) Order 2003(a).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by the Council of the Borough of Kirklees to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for related alterations of district ward boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by the Council of the Borough of Kirklees (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2009. The functions of the Electoral Commission relating to boundary change were transferred to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England on 1st April 2010.

The new boundaries apply in respect of district elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2011.

Article 3 alters Almondbury; Colne Valley; Crosland Moor and Nethererton; Holme Valley North; and Kirkburton district wards.
